Team Mini-project vs. Self-paced



- In Team: Students will complete tasks in a small team led by a scrum mentor. They will build an infrastructure together. The whole process of working in a team simulates a real work environment which is a very beneficial skill for graduates' future jobs.
- **Self-paced:** Students will complete tasks individually to build the project.

Scrum Teams vs. NO Scrum Teams

• **Scrum Team:** Starting from the 2nd month and until the end of the program, students will become a part of a scrum team (around 10 people) with a dedicated scrum mentor.

3 Mock Interviews vs. 1 General Mock Interview

- 3 Mock Interviews: These simulate a real interviewing process. You will go through a three-stage interviewing process:
 - Screening (phone call with a real Recruiter)
 - Behavioral interview
 - Technical interview

These 3-stage Mock Interviews are conducted by highly experienced professionals, each specializing in a specific area: recruiting, soft skills for tech companies, and technical expertise. Here, you will also receive an extra retake of each interview, allowing you to polish your skills and fully prepare for real interviews.

 1 General Mock Interview: This will test your knowledge as it would in a real interview and provide feedback on areas for improvement. This interview is conducted by an experienced DevOps Engineer.
